Old Business

- Field house clean up completed and ready for winter maintenance.

New Business

- This month vote on standing rules
- GYB By laws govern group. Standing Rules are used for day to day operations of GYB.
- Henry Belcher, current football coordinator, has a petition signed by 66 individuals. Petition references opposition to proposed changes of GYB by laws as it pertains to the selection of sport coordinators. Reference to the selection of coordinators should remain with the parents and the ability to vote not be appointed by GYB Board.

Recommendations for electoral process going forward:

- Expectations of coordinators explained by Board and a signed job description. Including attendance of monthly meetings.
- Board should consider interviewing groups of candidates and funnel selection down to three for public to vote on.
- Still give public chance to vote (bylaws) but change standing rule to allow Board to act on issues quicker. Example: rogue coaches or coordinators that could be deemed harmful to players, fans. Inappropriate behavior, etc.
- Election – do a bio for candidate and ask them to attend prior meeting.

Bryan Belcher – Feels like board has already made up our mind about vote and is disturbed by this deeply.

Kirk Wilkes- GYB not ran like a business currently and it should be. Give the Board ability to take care of issues within organization and act quicker

Conversation started by Henry Belcher regarding definition of ex officio member, Donna Wooldridge. Not the same as a member at large. Lifetime member instead.

Sport Updates:

Soccer – I badge needs to be turned in.

Cheerleaders –GYB Board appreciates a job well done and working with the kids this season
